Milton Reimers Ranch Park is a new park on the Pedernales River in southwest Travis County. It was purchased in 2006 with park bond funds which will also be used for park improvements. A proposed master plan for these improvements is now being presented to the public for their review. The intent of this plan is to provide existing users – the rock climbers, mountain bikers, fishermen, and birders who have been visiting “Reimers Fish Camp” for many years – with the amenities they need to enjoy the park even more than they do now, and to develop the park so more people will visit, to walk nature trails, picnic, hike, bike, and enjoy the river and Hill Country scenery.
